5. New Business

A Mayor Anderson opened a Public Hearing in reference to the City of Patton Village Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget. There were no questions or comments. The Public Hearing closed at 5:41 p.m.

B. Motion was made by Councilman Hershman and seconded by Councilman Crittenden to pass an Ordinance approving and adopting the City of Patton Village, Texas, General Budget for the Year 2021-2022; making appropriations for the City such year as reflected in said budget; establishing the procedures for intra-budget transfers; and containing other provisions relating to the subject.

C. Motion was made by Councilman Hershman and seconded by Councilman Young to ratify the City of Patton Village, Texas, General Budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 to find that the Budget's Proposed Tax Rate will raise more property taxes than last year's budget by \$24,887 or 15.03% and of that amount \$7,206 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year.

D. Mayor Anderson opened a Public Hearing regarding the City of Patton Village's proposed Tax Rate of \$0.2558 per \$100.00 of assessed value. The Mayor explained that the proposed Tax rate of \$0.2558 was the same tax rate passed for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. There were no questions or comments.

E. Motion was made by Councilman Young and seconded by Councilman Crittenden to adopt \$0.0519 as the portion of the Tax Rate to fund the Debt Service of the City of Patton Village for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

Motion was made by Councilman Young and seconded by Councilman Hershman to approve an Ordinance of the City of Patton Village, Texas; providing for the levy and collection of Ad Valorem taxes of the City of Patton Village, Texas for the Year 2021; providing the date on which such Ad Valorem taxes shall be due and payable; providing for penalty and interest on all taxes not timely paid; providing for severability; and, repealing all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith. The motion specifically stated, "I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.2558, which is effectively an 11.12% in the tax rate."
